The City Council of the City of Fort Morgan, Colorado, met this day in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The Honorable Mayor Ron Shaver called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

The meeting was also attended by City Attorney Geoff Wilson.

At the outset of the meeting, Mayor Ron Shaver announced that the purpose of the special meeting was to conduct an executive session. This executive session had been published as follows:

**EXECUTIVE SESSION** for discussion of a personnel matter under C.R.S. Section 24-6-402(4)(f) and not involving: any specific employees who have requested discussion of the matter in open session; any member of this body or any elected official; the appointment of any person to fill an office of this body or of an elected official; or personnel policies that do not require the discussion of matters personal to particular employees; and for the purpose of determining positions relative to matters that may be subject to negotiations, developing strategy for negotiations, and/or instructing negotiators, under C.R.S. Section 24-6-402(4)(e); AND THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL DETAILS ARE PROVIDED FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES: Discussion with City Manager Candidate Steve Glammeyer.

Councilmember Clint Anderson made a motion to convene this executive session, which was seconded by Councilmember Doug Schossow and approved on a unanimous vote of 6-0, with Councilmember Brian Urdiales absent.

The executive session began at 6:04 p.m. and concluded at 7:36 p.m., and was attended by the mayor and four council members in person and Councilmember Kevin Lindell by computer link (Urdiales absent).

At the conclusion of the executive session the council returned to the open special meeting, where Councilmember Allison Howe reported that the council met in executive session for the purpose stated on the agenda. Howe then made a motion to appoint Steve Glammeyer as the new city manager and instruct the attorney to negotiate the parameters of a contract.

Mayor Shaver adjourned the July 1, 2020 special meeting at 7:37 p.m.
