The City Council of the City of Fort Morgan, Colorado, met this day in the council chambers of City Hall. The Honorable Mayor Ron Shaver called the special meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

The meeting was also attended by City Manager Steve Glammeyer and City Attorney Geoff Wilson.

After some introductory direction from Wilson regarding the form of questions and the order of activities at the meeting, the council interviewed police chief finalists Eric Powell and Loren Sharp. Following the completion of the interviews, council received comments from the members of the citizen panel that had also separately interviewed both finalists. Council then discussed among themselves both applicants.

Councilmember Kevin Lindell made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Jon Kaper, to select Loren Sharp as Fort Morgan's next police chief, with a one-year contract, followed by a salary adjustment if that contract is renewed, and a review by the council after six months. That motion was approved on a roll call vote of 6-1, with Councilmember Doug Schossow voting against. Further discussion of logistical matters ensued.

Mayor Shaver adjourned the Nov. 21 special meeting at 2:00 p.m.
