July 11 - Planet garden planting: Venus veggies and Mercury mud.

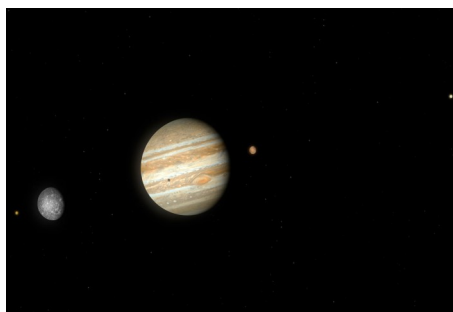
1:30 p.m. - Book - "June 29, 1999."
